	Writing aims		Year 1: read own writing aloud clearly for others to hear and discuss. use spaces between words. Reception: begin to spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sounds with letters. Begin to form lower-case and capital letters correctly.
	Communication & Language	Speaking & listening aims	Year 1: Explain their understanding of what is read to them. Reception: Listen to and talk about stories to build familiarity and understanding. Use new vocabulary in different contexts. Ask question to find out more and check understanding. Articulate ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences.
	Maths aims		Year 1: addition and subtraction within 10, then 20. Reception: numbers 1-5, counting backwards from 5, 1 more, 1 less, part whole, addition/subtraction up to 5. ABC patterns, doubling (see EYFS LTP) Year 1 Materials
Understanding the World	The Natural World	Science aims	 Distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made -ldentify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock. Describe the simple properties of everyday materials. Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.
	People, Culture & Communities	Geography aims	Where does the gingerbread man go? The world - locate the equator, n & s poles using an atlas/globe. Hot and cold places in the world; describe similarities and differences between the natural world around them and contrasting environment Tell something about people who live in hot and cold places.
