Summer 1 Dragons and Drawbridges

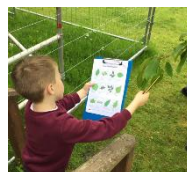

The children have spent weeks getting to know the story, orally rehearsing and then carefully plotting and planning their alternative version, concluding in them writing a wonderful book.
