

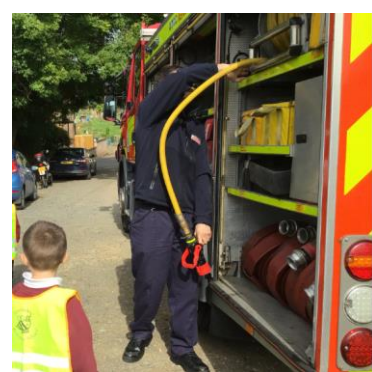
Willow Class Autumn Term 1
