

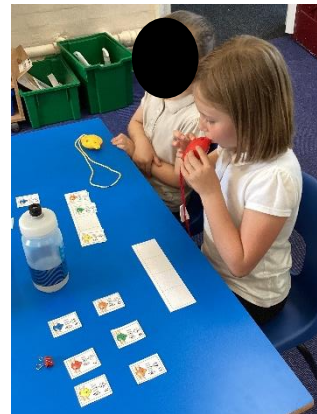
Ash Class - Summer 2 – Amazing Humans
