

## Pure Imagination

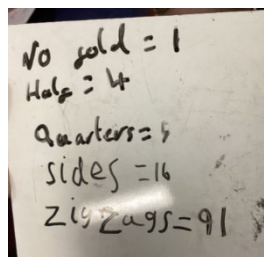

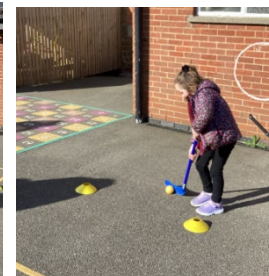
We have been using and building on the clay skills that we learned earlier in the year to create our very own dragon eyes linked to our descriptions too!
