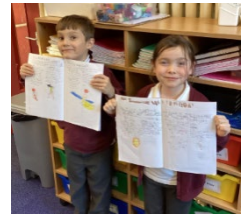
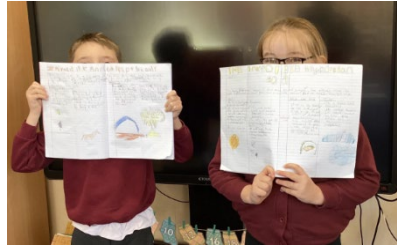
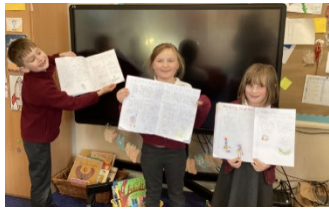


## Mummy Mayhem – Life in Ancient Egypt
