



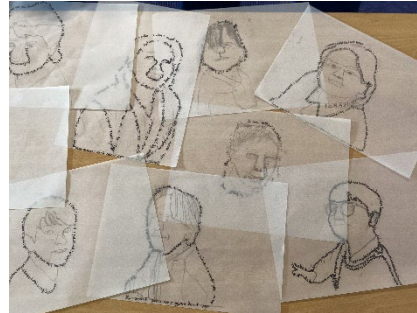
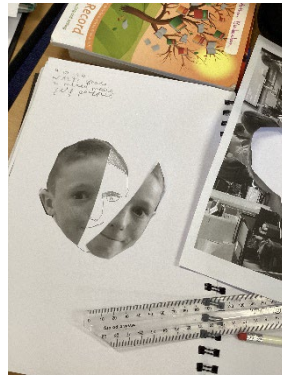
## Oak class Autumn Term 1
