

Somerby School PE and Sports Funding

A wide range of PE has been delivered at Somerby Primary School. We are supported by Premier Sports and Longfield Specialist PE Teachers to deliver the curriculum to all children. We aim to deliver exciting and stimulating lessons to inspire children to become active and enjoy the benefits that sport can bring into all aspects of their life. We are using the PE and Sports Premium funding to raise the standards of PE teaching in the school by using specialist teachers and coaches to deliver high quality lessons by experts to the children. We teach a variety of activities in competitive and non competitive environments.

In addition to this the school also offers out of school sports activities twice a week, this caters for children of all primary school age and all children are actively encouraged to participate in these specialist run sports clubs. These clubs are free to children and are fully funded by the Sports Premier funding.

The funding has also gone to supporting the school in taking the children to other schools to participate in sports activities, workshops and specialist lessons, such as swimming lessons.

In addition to the extended opportunities children are given inside and outside the school timetabled day, we are offering extended CPD to all staff. This will be delivered by external coaches, teachers and specialists who will model lessons for staff, increase staff knowledge of different areas of the PE curriculum and to network with other schools to create closer links and more opportunity for the children and staff to meet and share positive and high quality experiences.

The impact of our PE and Sports Premium funding can be seen in the development of the children and their attitude to sport. The children have experienced high quality lessons that have enhanced their experiences of PE at school. They have gained an enthusiasm for many different sports and gained knowledge of these sports that has impacted in their own life. Many children are more active at playtimes and play an increasing number of sporting games and choosing to peruse sports clubs outside the ones provided for by school.

Money left in the sports funding for the rest of the term will be a continuation of the successful lessons in school and sports clubs outside school. Money in the summer term will concentrate on CPD of staff members, buying equipment to enhance children's sporting, agility and sensory ability in break times and updating sports facilities and equipment to enhance lessons. A week of sports activities for the whole school is planned in summer to give children the opportunities to enhance experiences and try different sports that they might not have considered before.
